



Northwest Regional Basketball Tournament 2009 Eligibility

2008-2009 National Federation of State High School Association Rules will be used with the following modifications/restrictions. The tournament rules committee reserves will address any policies or procedures not specifically addressed in this document.

Eligibility:

- Players must be enrolled in the institution they are representing and must be eligible to compete in that institution's intramural sports program.
- Teams representing military installations are also eligible to compete, with all members of these teams consisting of persons that are assigned to that respective military installation.
- 2007-2008 or current intercollegiate basketball players are **not** eligible to participate in the national tournament. NCAA collegiate basketball players must sit out one (1) full academic year in the Northwest Regional Basketball Tournament.
- Faculty/Staff members of a respective institution are **not** allowed to compete for their institution regardless of any institution's intramural program policies permitting such action in the course of operating their program on their respective campus.
- Alumni are **not** allowed to represent an institution regardless of any institution's intramural program policies permitting such action in the course of operating their program on their respective campus.
- Players must present a valid picture ID (example: School ID, military ID, or drivers license) before every contest.
- The intramural/recreation director of each team must approve and sign each team's roster prior to competition.
- The minimum requirement for eligibility is half of full-time enrollment for undergraduate students and a minimum of six (6) credit hours for graduate students. Participants must be enrolled in credits 45 days prior to the event.
- **Players must have the registrar of their institution verify their academic status on the entry form prior to coming to the tournament to be eligible.**
- Players listed on any institution's ejection list are not eligible to participate in this tournament.
